Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find below the information for our planned opening in September. All children start school on **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

### **The School Day**

- 8:45 - 8:55 school opens for children to enter classrooms
- 8:55 - 9:00 registration closes
- 3:15 school day ends

### **Lunchtime**

- Ducklings and Harlequin is 12:00 – 1:00
- King Eider and Mandarin is 12:15 – 1:15

### **Arrival**

Children and parents should not enter the school grounds before 8:45am. Children can enter the grounds through either the church gate on the bottom playground or the pedestrian entrance and then walk around to the playground past the forest school area.

A member of staff will greet children on the top playground at 8:45am. Children will then enter their classes in the following ways:

Ducklings and Harlequin – through their outdoor area gate.

King Eider and Mandarin – through the double doors on the top playground.

### **Collection**

Parents can wait on the top playground for children at 3:15. Teachers will release their classes back to you. If your child will be walking home on their own, please contact their teachers in September via Seesaw to make them aware of this.

### **Ordering Lunches**

Dinner money should be sent into the school office in a labelled envelope on a Monday for that week, detailing the days that the children are having them. Mrs Pick has already sent the menus via Seesaw; Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September will be Week 1. For infants, school dinners are free, for juniors it is £2.45 unless you are eligible for free school meals.

### **Before and After School Clubs**

Mrs Pick has sent a letter out regarding clubs before and after school. For further information on these, please ring the school office in September.



### **PE Days**

On PE days, children should come to school in their PE kits – please ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather.

Here are the class PE days:

Monday – Ducklings and Harlequin

Tuesday – Mandarin and Ducklings

Thursday – Mandarin and King Eider

Friday – Ducklings and Harlequin

King Eider will also be going swimming which will be their second PE session on a Friday.

### **Snacks for Breaktimes**

Children should bring a water bottle that they will have access to during the day. Ducklings and Harlequin will be provided with fruit through the government scheme. King Eider and Mandarin may bring a healthy snack e.g. fruit or a cereal bar – not chocolate or crisps please.
